

Registering for a course

- Registrations & payment must be made prior to attending an I-CAR training session.
- Once you have registered for a course you are agreeing to attend that training session at the date, time & location specified on the registration form.
- Failure to attend the training session will mean forfeit of course cost. (refer to terms & conditions)

Attending the course

- Turn up to the training on time & ready to learn.
- Respect & follow your instructor.
- A student registration form must be completed when attending each course. Any student correspondence will be sent to the email address provided to us by the student on this form.

Testing

- At the end of each course students will be given a multiple choice post test to complete – this is the final part to attending a course. (Practical tests will be required for all Welding Certification & Hands-On Skills Training)
- When taking the post test you will be allowed to use class notes and objective worksheets provided.
- Students who do not pass the post test will have the opportunity to review the program materials and retake a post test at no additional cost.
- Students who do not pass the re-test will be required to sit the entire course again.
