

Student Code of Conduct

All students are expected to follow the student code of conduct while on site at the I-CAR Training Academy.

This includes:

- No smoking is allowed onsite or in the proximity of the premises.
- No offensive language or behaviour is permitted on premises.
- Not use, possess or supply a prohibited weapon or any prohibited substance on premises
- Be free from the influence of alcohol and/or drugs while on premises.
- Possessions, materials, and equipment should be secured and not be left unattended.
- Follow all Instructor instructions while on premises.
- Comply with any reasonable request or directions from I-CAR Australia staff with regard to safety or compliance with policy, procedure or ethical requirements, or to provide name or proof of identity.
- Only operate any training equipment under supervision and follow Instructor instructions.
- Read the Safety Work Procedure on the wall before operating any equipment if applicable
- Use I-CAR Australia property or resources, including communication technology resources, cooperatively, legally, ethically, responsibly and appropriately
- Entrance to other areas of the premises aside from the training areas is prohibited, unless permitted by I-CAR staff.
- Place all personal litter and debris in the appropriate rubbish bins provided.
- Report any problems, hazards, or incidents immediately to your Instructor or other members of the I-CAR team.
- Dress appropriately and wear the correct personal protective equipment suitable for the training to be undertaken.
- No pets are permitted on premises.
- Park in I-CAR designated parking lots or street park on the service road.
- Follow any health and safety signage on premises.
- Take responsibility for your learning.
- Act with honesty and integrity
- Interact with respect and fairness with other students and staff at all times.
- Contribute to a healthy and safe learning environment.
- Seek support or assistance from your Instructor or the I-CAR team when required.
